Repentance: On this Second Sunday of Advent we hear the account of the ministry of John the Baptist inviting all to repentance. The Baptist is in the wilderness, location of a primitive life, but he is immensely popular. He is humble. He proclaims the imminent coming of the Messiah, It is important that John proclaims the Advent of the Messiah in the wilderness. The desert for him is a symbol of the religious situation of Israel. John attracts the common people into the wilderness to hear his message of repentance so that they are purified and spiritually ready for the coming of the Messiah. In advent season let us let go of all bitterness and allow God to work healing in our life. Perhaps we need to draw closer to Him. Like the prodigal son's father, God will run to meet us. He will throw His arms around us and He will forgive us and restore us. CS Lewis writes that though God made us without our consent, He will not save us without our permission. Fr. Saju.
