Dust to Dawn: Lent is a journey which begins with the dust of Ash Wednesday and ends with the dawn of Easter Sunday. Therefore we take Dust to Dawn as our theme for this Lent. Ashes remind us that we are created from the earth and it connects us with the rest of humanity and to all living things. While dust reminds us of our vulnerabilities and challenges, Lent offers us opportunities for spiritual renewal.

Lenten penance according to Pope Francis is a commitment, sustained by grace, to overcoming our lack of faith and our resistance to following Jesus on the way of the cross. Further in his message for this Lent, Pope Francis invites us to spend time to listen to the voice of Jesus as admonished at the time of the Transfiguration. Pope Francis writes, "Lent is a time of grace to the extent that we listen to him as he speaks to us. And how does he speak to us? First, in the word of God, which the Church offers us in the liturgy. May that word not fall on deaf ears; if we cannot always attend Mass, let us study its daily biblical readings, even with the help of the internet. In addition to the Scriptures, the Lord speaks to us through our brothers and sisters, especially in the faces and the stories of those who are in need". Emphasizing the importance of focusing on Jesus in our Lenten journey, the Pope comments, "Here is the second proposal for this Lent: do not take refuge in a religiosity made up of extraordinary events and dramatic experiences, out of fear of facing reality and its daily struggles, its hardships and contradictions. The light that Jesus shows the disciples is an anticipation of Easter glory, and that must be the goal of our own journey, as we follow 'him alone'. Let us prayerfully read and reflect on the word of God and set apart quality time to be with the Lord alone in this Lent. Fr. Saju
