Pentecost: Today, we are celebrating Pentecost Sunday. After His Resurrection Jesus told the disciples to wait in Jerusalem for the Father's gift of the Holy Spirit, from whom they would receive power to be His witnesses to the ends of the earth. The Holy Spirit like tongues of fire descended on this day upon the disciples and Mother Mary who were gathered in the upper room imparting to them newness of life and vitality. The languages of those disciples filled with the Holy Spirit became courageous witnesses of the Good News of Jesus. Today the Church speaks in the tongues of all men and women of every race, culture, and nationality. She speaks with a common language of Christ's love. We, the disciples of Jesus are the witness to the love of Christ in our time. Today's Gospel narrates that Jesus breathed on his disciples. The breathing recalls God breathing life into the dust and bringing the first human being into existence. Here too there is a kind of creation, the disciples are recreated into the new persons. Similarly through baptism and confirmation, we too have been made apostles of Christ and are called to proclaim and spread the Gospel in the various contexts of our lives. Most of us will know from our family situations, friendship circles, and workplaces, that witnessing to the Gospel is not always an easy task. We ask for the Holy Spirit to give us strength to live with faithfulness and perseverance, through the joys and through the trials of our lives every day. Fr. Saju
