Gospel reflection: In Luke 18:9–14, Jesus presents the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector as a mirror to our own hearts, exposing the danger of spiritual pride and the beauty of genuine humility. The Pharisee, standing confidently in the temple, prays with self-congratulation, boasting of his fasting and tithing, and comparing himself favourably to others whom he considers sinners. His focus is not on God but on himself and his supposed righteousness. In contrast, the tax collector, deeply aware of his unworthiness, stands at a distance, unable even to lift his eyes to heaven. Beating his chest in sorrow, he cries out, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner." Jesus declares that it is the tax collector, not the Pharisee, who goes home justified before God. This parable reminds us that God looks not at outward appearances or religious achievements, but at the posture of our hearts. True righteousness cannot be earned through our deeds or moral superiority; it is a gift received through humble faith and repentance. As we reflect on this story, we are called to examine our own hearts, letting go of judgment, pride, and self-righteousness and to approach God and others with humility, gratitude, and compassion, knowing that it is only by His mercy that we are made right.
