The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome—the Pope's cathedral and the mother church of all churches. Built by Emperor Constantine in the fourth century and originally called the "Basilica Salvatoris," it was first dedicated solely to the Saviour, a sign of the early Church's reverence for Christ alone. Later, a Benedictine community of St John the Baptist and St John the Evangelist was attached, and the basilica acquired its triple dedication to the Most Holy Saviour, St John the Baptist and St John the Evangelist, reflecting its living tradition. The Lateran has long been honoured as "Omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater, et caput," the mother and head of every church on earth, symbolizing the unity of the whole Church and the central place of the Pope, the Bishop of Rome, as its shepherd. This feast invites us to recognize the Lateran's role as the spiritual heart of our faith, uniting believers everywhere and anchoring the Church's life in the presence of Christ. Fr Bibin
