Gospel Reflection.

John the Baptist is a very powerful preacher in today's Gospel. He is fearless. He says, "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" and he calls the Sadducees and Pharisees a brood of vipers and asked them twice to produce good fruit. That would prove they were serious about repentance. I am not sure if there are many preachers today who would preach the truth so boldly or clearly as John. Later, John continued his bold preaching and told Herod (Antipas), the son of Herod the Great who slaughtered the children around Bethlehem after the birth of Jesus, that he should not have married his brother's ex-wife (Matt 14:3-4). Then, as now, when the truth is preached, people get upset. Herod's wife, the ex-wife of his brother, got upset and so John ended up in prison for preaching the truth. He was put into prison because what he said was not politically correct. That could happen nowadays also in certain places, being put in prison for saying what is not politically correct. The liberals are not always broadminded enough to include the truth in what they hear; they only want to hear what suits them. *Fr Philip*
